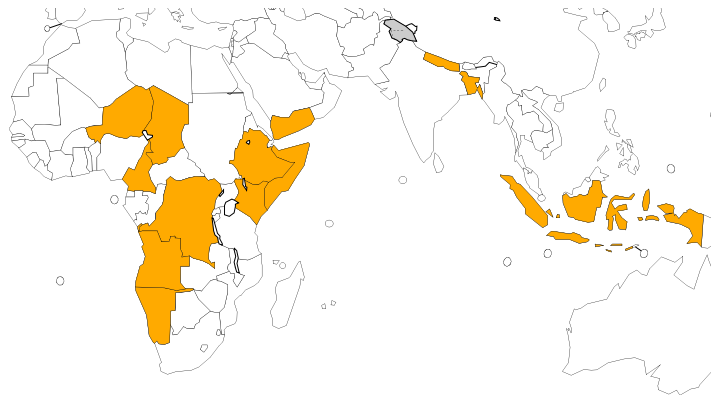


RE-INFECTED COUNTRIES

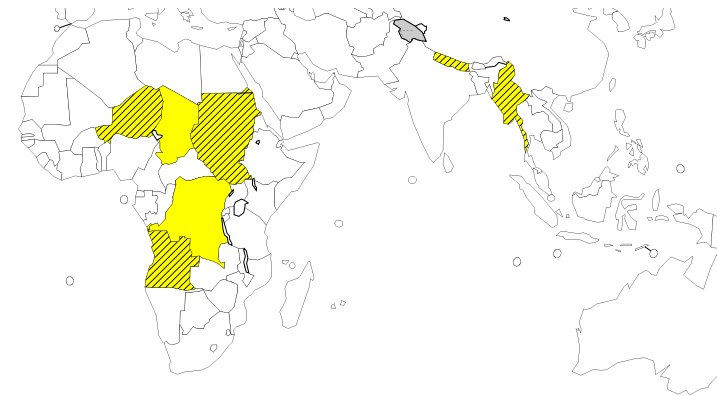
Milestone 3:	By end-2007, countries re-infected in 2006 will have implemented appropriate response activities and interrupted transmission of the imported poliovirus.
Status:	Original importations stopped in 11 of 13 countries. Noteworthy stopped outbreaks are Indonesia, Somalia and Yemen, which interrupted polio transmission again by full implementation of outbreak response guidelines. Transmission of imported poliovirus circulating in 2006 continues in Chad and Democratic Republic of Congo.
